Camp Week
July 27 – 31, 2020

Dear Campers and Parents:

Well it's almost the most wonderful time of the year again! Of course, we're talking about camp time. As I have often pointed out, statistically, more individuals receive Christ as their personal Savior before the age of 20, than any other age. It has been a great joy to my heart to see more than 100 young people come to the Lord and countless others rededicate their lives to Him during the annual week of the Young People's Bible Conference.

The theme for camp this year is, "20/20 Vision," using the Bible verse Proverbs 29:18. Many fun activities will be planned, and a fair amount of time will be given for instruction through Bible lessons and worship services. We will be making our trip to Carowinds on Wednesday and then travel to Fun Depot on Thursday.

As always, transportation will be provided from the designated location to and from camp. Those locations will be announced at a later time. The fee for camp will be \$350 per camper. The fee includes all costs except spending money. Campers will receive one snack per day provided by the camp. We will have a concessions booth for campers to purchase extra snacks if they would like. Snacks will be priced so that a few dollars should be enough. They will need money for lunch on the trip to and from camp, and spending money for the Fun Depot and Carowinds trips. Both the Fun Depot and Carowinds fees will be included within the camp cost.

This year, camp will be from Monday, July 27th through Friday, the 31st. We will be arriving home on Friday evening. Calls will be made in advance Friday during the day, so everyone will have time to arrange pickup.

The attached camper application should be completed, signed by both parents and campers, being sure to read all materials, and returned to me, along with a \$100 registration payment, no later than Friday, May 29, 2020. The balance of \$250 is due on or before Tuesday, June 30, 2020, a month prior to departure. As always, we will consider applications taken after May 31st on a first come, first served basis. Therefore, it is imperative to have all applications turned in by May 31st, so that transportation and pickup locations can be arranged. We try never to turn anyone away, but space is limited, giving the reason for the first come, first served basis after the deadline. As always, the team of YPBC looks forward to serving you and your camper during the best week of the year.
