# 2021 Safety Guidelines

The CYC Staff, as well as all other weeks of camp, are familiar with required protocols and procedures to ensure safety. These guidelines will help to keep campers and staff safe and healthy. Cragmont has implemented safety protocols in conjunction with the National Camp Association and the CDC. Among the protocols directly effecting camp at Cragmont this year includes the following stipulations to abide by distancing and safety guidelines.

- 1) Camp will operate near half capacity, which is 125 total (campers and staff).
- 2) No charter buses will be used. Thus families and/or churches, using personal vehicles/vans/buses, will be responsible for dropping off campers and picking up campers within the time frame given. Campers can NOT drive themselves to camp.
- 3) All weeks will be shortened to Monday through Friday - this will allow campers to be picked up/dropped off at a time that does not force parents to have to stay in the area. It will also allow the Cragmont staff more time to properly clean and disinfect all areas of camp prior to the next week of camp starting.
- 4) Campers will remain in small cohorts / family groups / tribes and will only interact with other family groups through social distancing and wearing face masks.
- 5) Campers will room two per room and dorm capacity will be cut in half. We will be spread out around camp and this may mean that campers may not be bunking in their traditional spots.
- 6) Increased disinfecting, hand washing and sanitation protocol will be followed.
- 7) All campers, staff and Cragmont staff will wear masks and follow social distancing guidelines.
- 8) All possible activities will be held outside and when inside and possible, windows will be opened to increase the flow of fresh air.
