The **greatest** camping experience for the summer of 2021 is right here...**General Youth Conference at Cragmont!** Due to imposed capacity restrictions, only campers completed grades 5 through 12 will be eligible to attend.

We are excited and grateful we will be having camp this year, however, it will look somewhat different. Students will be grouped together into pods, which will consist of their dormmates, and will stay in that group much of the week.

Due to canceling of GYC in 2020, students who were registered, but missed their *senior year* of GYC will be permitted to go this year, but please specify that below. There are additional changes for **this year** due to the restrictions posed by the state regarding capacity protocol, thus the change in grades allowed this year. Camp capacity at this time has been reduced, so do not wait! Registrations will be processed in the order received, so do not wait. **Buses are not an option this year**. Therefore, parents and churches will need to work together to assure the transport of your campers to Cragmont on Monday, July 19, as well as pick up on Friday, July 23.

The registration fee for camp for this year will be reduced to **\$300** per camper which includes food and lodging at Cragmont, daily snacks, group picture, activity fee, T-shirt, as well as other wonderful activities!

Please complete the registration form below and return no later than **May 25th** with a \$150 deposit. PLEASE NOTE: A deposit MUST accompany this form. NO FORM will be registered without a deposit – no exceptions. If your church pays for camp – they need to send a registration check. The \$150 balance and room request form (which will be mailed after registrations are received) will be due by **June 14th**. Checks should be made payable to **GENERAL YOUTH CONFERENCE**. Please note: the \$150 deposit is **NON-refundable** after June 14, 2021. **The only exception is if your family has to cancel due to a Covid-related issue, such as testing positive, or come in contact with someone who has tested positive within 2 weeks of camp.**

2021 Safety Guidelines

The GYC Staff as well as all the other camp weeks will become familiar with required protocols and procedures to ensure safety. These guidelines will help to keep campers and staff safe and healthy. Cragmont has implemented safety protocols in conjunction with the National Camp Association and the CDC. Among the protocols directly effecting camp at Cragmont this year includes the following stipulations to abide by distancing and safety guidelines.

1. Camp will operate near half capacity, which is 125 total (campers and staff).
2. No charter buses will be used. Thus families or churches, using vans/church buses, will be responsible for bringing the campers.
3. Campers will remain in cohorts / family groups / tribes of 10 or less and will only interact with other family groups through social distancing and wearing of face masks.
4. Increased disinfecting, hand washing, and sanitation protocol will be followed.
5. All campers, staff, and Cragmont staff will wear masks and follow social distancing guidelines.
6. All possible activities will be held outside and when inside and possible, windows will be opened to increase the flow of fresh air.
7. All weeks will be shortened to Monday through Friday - this will allow for campers to be picked up at a time that does not force parents to have to stay in the area, but will also allow more time for Cragmont staff to properly clean and disinfect all areas of camp.
